

25 Tips for Getting Your Home Market Ready

EXTERIOR:

- 1. Pressure wash the exterior, driveway, deck & porch
- 2. Freshen up landscaping with mulch or pine straw
- 3. Trim your shrubs
- 4. Clean gutters and make sure downspouts are clear and extended away from foundation
- 5. Repair areas of rotted trim, siding & doors/door frames
- 6. Freshen up paint on front door, surrounding trim and porch
- 7. Clean windows and remove all window screens
- 8. Place a flower basket near the entryway
- 9. Replace your welcome mat
- 10. Clean your outside furniture and consider sprucing it up with new cushions and pillows

INTERIOR:

- 1. Repaint bold colors (in at least 75% of the home)
- 2. Patch and paint drywall cracks above doors & window frames
- 3. Remove wall paper or borders
- 4. Replace light fixtures that are brass
- 5. Professionally clean carpets or replace if the edges are darkened & cannot be cleaned
- 6. Thoroughly clean entire home, to include ceiling fans, window sills, blinds, baseboards, cobwebs in corners, door handles, etc.
- 7. Remove clutter, collections & all personal photos don't forget the closets!
- 8. Change air filters & clean air vents
- 9. Check and repair caulking around tubs, showers, sinks, and counters
- 10. Remove all items from bathroom counters except soap
- 11. Put fresh hand towels in bathrooms
- 12. Remove all items from kitchen counters except things you use every day (like a coffee maker or knife block)
- 13. Make sure your kitchen appliances are all matching (brands don't matter as much as colors)
- 14. Remove small rugs from baths & kitchens
- 15. Take down all curtains
